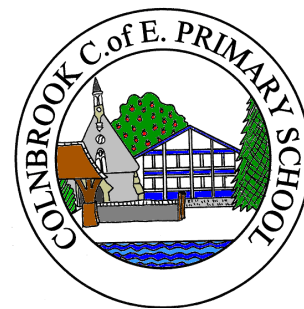

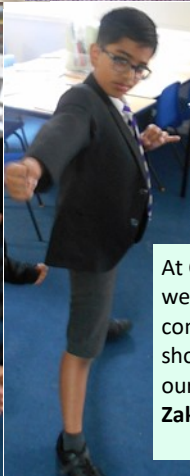
In Mrs Hurst's Lego club, **Nevaeh, Year 3** designed and built a cow. *Well done, Nevaeh!*
