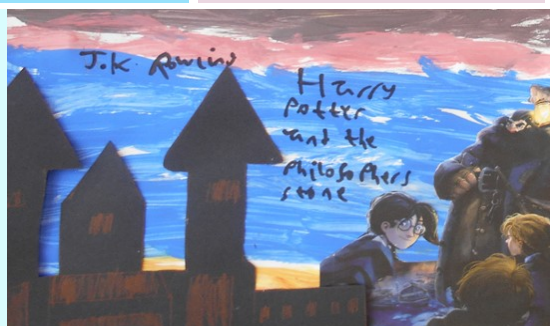
5 Finger Prayer

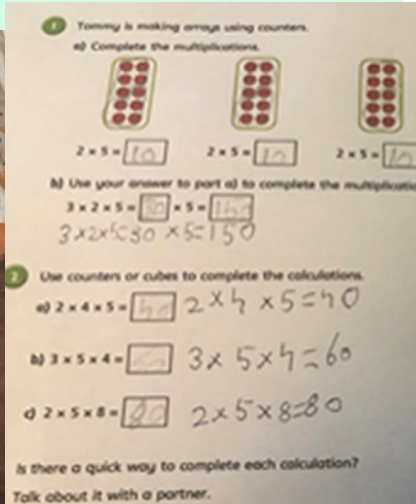
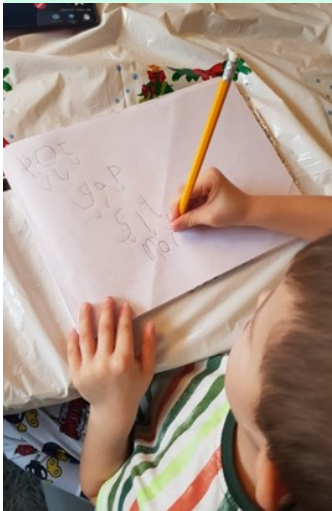
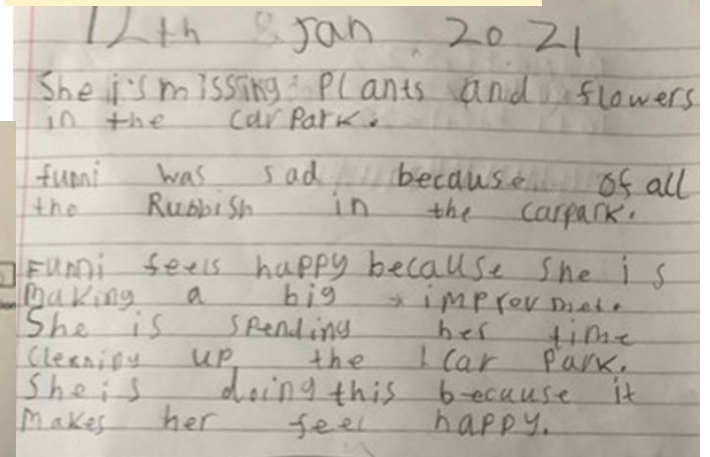


Aaliyah and Eduard in Reception Class have been practising their yoga moves, and **Nathan** has been practising spelling different words by himself.

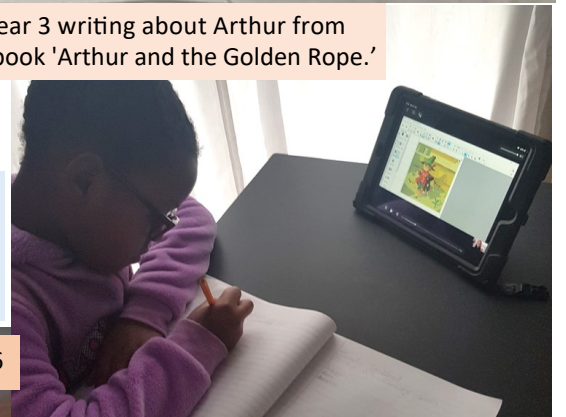
Amy, Year 1 is matching each dinosaur to its fossil.

Tamelia, Year 3 writing about Arthur from their new book 'Arthur and the Golden Rope.'



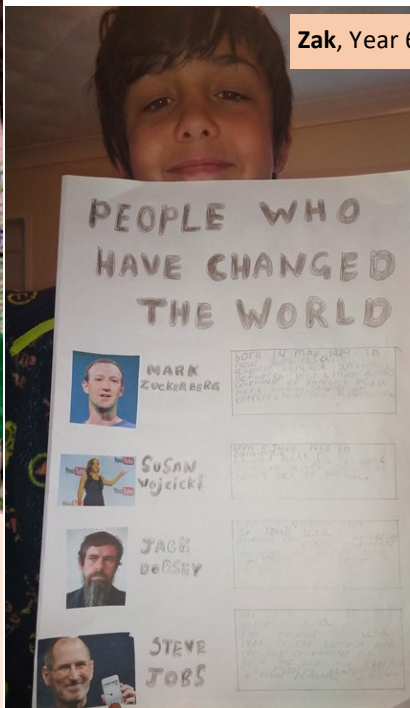
Year 4's focus in maths has been Multiplication. They have learnt to multiply 3 numbers together.
