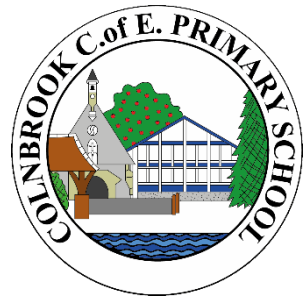

Dear Parents and Carers,

Firstly, I would like to say a big thank you for your continued support during this national lockdown. Staff are very appreciative of your kind words and messages of support over recent weeks and I know you are doing a fantastic job supporting your children's learning at home. A good partnership between school and parents is always essential, and I sincerely appreciate all the time and effort you have put in to support your children in these exceptional times.

I have not, as yet, received any further information from the Department for Education regarding the wider opening of schools. I am expecting some announcements to be made over half term, and the Prime Minister has said he will make a further announcement on 22<sup>nd</sup> February. I will write to you again, after the half term holiday, and hope to have more information to share with you.
