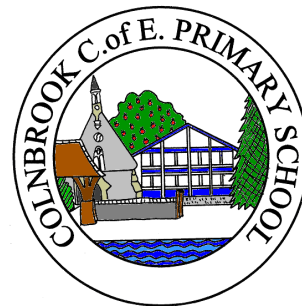

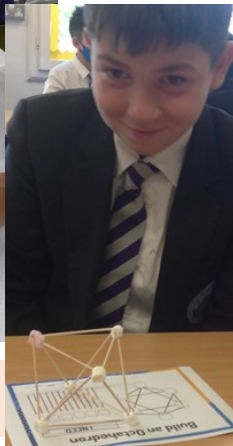
Please remember to bring in a donation for Monday's Tombola and your child should bring in 50p on Monday if they want to buy a ticket.

## Maths Week

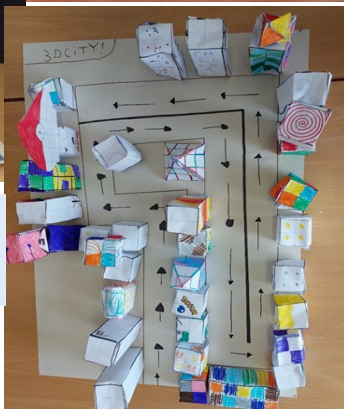

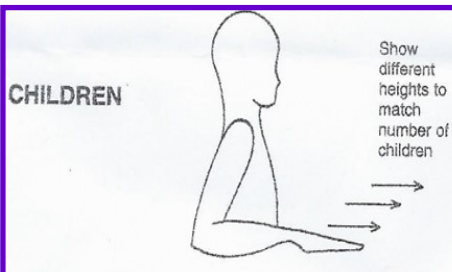


### Year 4 Class Assembly
